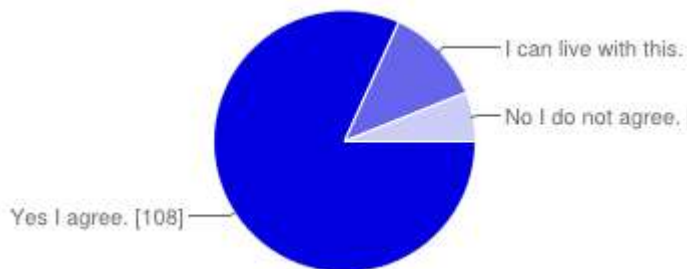
Survey questions

Pathways to identify leaders

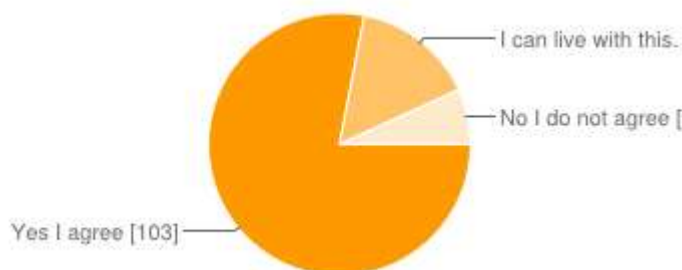
There are four pathways proposed that can be used solely, or most likely in combination, to identify suitable outdoor leaders, these are:

1. Organisational accreditation or qualification
2. Peer recognition and verification.
3. Formal training qualifications.
4. Leader registration schemes.

Identifying leadership skills

This strategy is used so that the lists can be updated without requiring a re-issue of a new version of the AAS.

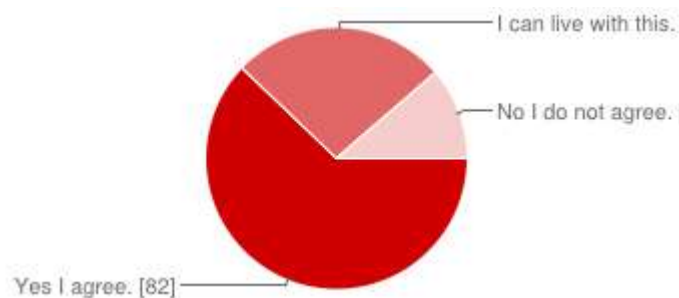
